



# **MAMMOTH TUFF TRAFFIC & TRANSIT ADVISORY FOR SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2024**

The Mammoth TUFF gravel bike ride will take place on Saturday, September 14, 2024, with over 500 cyclists expected to participate. The start and finish line of this bike ride is located in The Village on Canyon Blvd. As a result, a section of Canyon Blvd. between Lake Mary Rd and Hillside Drive will be closed from 5AM to 10PM. During this time frame, the bus stops in The Village on Canyon Blvd. will be inaccessible, which will impact several public transit routes.

## **PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGES TO THE STOPS ON THE FOLLOWING ROUTES FOR SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2024**

### **MAMMOTH BIKE PARK SHUTTLE NEW STOP:**

Pick-up/drop-off will be at stop #18 on Minaret Rd across the street from Old New York Deli.

### **LAKES BASIN TROLLEY (ESTA) NEW STOP:**

Pick-up/drop-off will be at the Village/ Minaret stop in front of Toomey's.

### **PURPLE/TEAL LINES (ESTA) NEW STOP:**

Pick-up/drop-off will be at the Village/ Minaret stop in front of Toomey's.

### **TOWN TROLLEY (ESTA) NEW STOP:**

Pick-up/drop-off will be at stop #18 on Minaret Rd across the street from Old New York Deli, as well as at the regular Village/Minaret stop in front of Toomey's.
